

PROTECTING YOUR PLOTS

Wildlife in the garden is a wonderful thing but sometimes it can get a little too interested in what you are growing.

Here is a simple and effective way to keep those curious foxes, pesky squirrels and hungry pigeons off your plot. So whether you have a planter or a grow bag you can protect your veg from unwanted visitors!

YOU WILL NEED:

4 bamboo canes,
60cm-1m long,

Garden wire

Crop Protection
Netting

Tiny panel or
drawing pins

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Push the bamboo canes onto a corner of your plots up against the planter stake, about 40cm down.
2. Wire the bamboo canes securely around the side panels
3. Along the inside rim of the planter edge, hammer or press in the tiny panel pins / drawing pins.
4. Drape the netting around the structure fully and secure the loose edges with the panel/drawing pins.



YOU WILL NEED:

4 Bamboo sticks

Crop Protection Netting

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Push the bamboo sticks into the 4 corners of the bag, about 40cm deep.
2. Wrap the netting around the structure and tuck into the inside edge.
